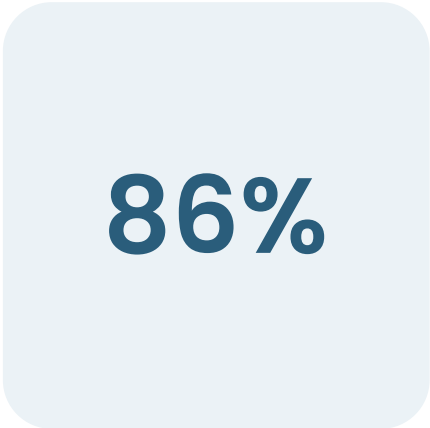


## GELT – Global English Level Test

The Global English Level Test assesses candidates' proficiency in reading, listening, grammar, and vocabulary skills, aligning results with CEFR levels (A1–C2) for an objective language assessment.

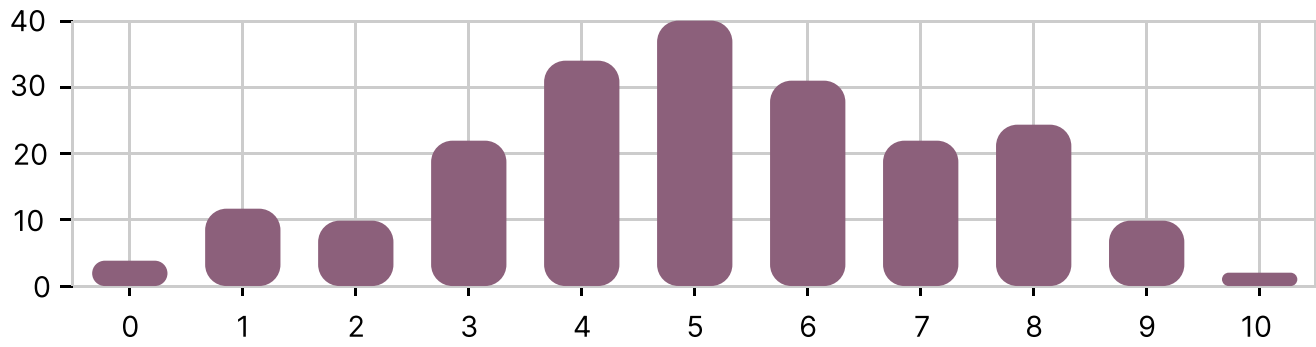
C2 is the highest level of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR), where the learner has an exceptional command of the language and can use it with ease and confidence in any situation. They can understand with ease virtually everything heard or read, and can summarise information from different spoken and written sources, reconstructing arguments and accounts in a coherent presentation. They can also express themselves spontaneously, very fluently and precisely, differentiating finer shades of meaning even in more complex situations. They have a near-native level of proficiency in the language.

The test was administered to a population of **81** individuals, with a resulting standard deviation of **33.02**.
